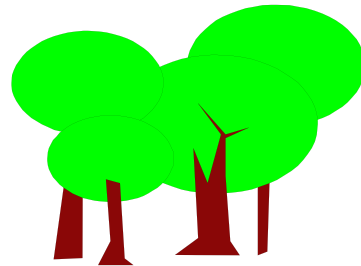




Ashton Heath Restoration

At the same time, some of the woodland is badly damaged by years of digging, with large quantities of ash brought to the surface.

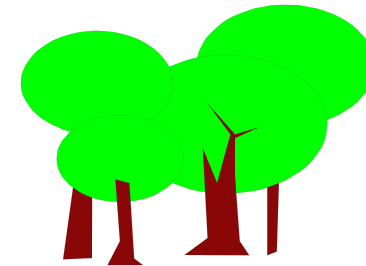
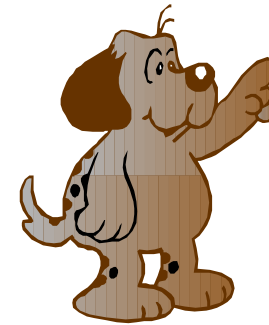
